Annual review of NottsWatch 2014-15

Year of transition 2014-15 started as NottsWatch was made up of main committee - Executive (Trustees) & two subcommittees - County & City. In addition, Steering Group. The year has finished with the city and county subcommittees dissolving in favour of a joint Management Team, as agreed at the Executive meeting 6 October 2014.

Action Plans:

County - 12 crime Prevention Training Sessions were agreed to be given with support of Notts Police. The initial session was well attended by NW members and invitees and held at The Arrow Centre April 2014. Sadly, there was a general lack of interest from NHW groups when offered out to the county. But well attended meetings were arranged for Bramcote, Mansfield, Radcliffe/Bingham and Arnold. In addition a smaller taster session plus NHW presentation was given at the Bramcote Community Action Team (CAT) meeting last December. A further two were planned for March at the Beeston Rylands and Attenborough CATs but postponed until after the Election.

PCC/Small grants

Website - A new amalgamated website was launched at the last AGM. A small team (TM, JL, SAS & ND) have further developed the website and will continue this work in the coming year. The "Register here" page remains the only page that hasn't been improved.

Social Media - NW joined facebook 31 October 2014 and twitter November 2012. We have over 100 "likes" and over 500 followers benefiting from posts relating to NHW, crime prevention advice and policing information. Social media is an addition to the alerts, sent via email, to share information electronically.
