Encouraging stats – discussed the potential for NWN to liaise with national residential developers and/or create a tool kit for associations enabling effective discussions re schemes set up with new builds to also involve planning department plus councillors. Sensitivity with wording required. Needs to be a selling point not alert of potential crime in the area. ACTION SAS to contact NWN.</p>

Progress in partnering with Notts CC Communities Team projects	SAS SSS	Tech & Tea – Stakeholder Planning meeting held 14 September. Result – AL, Notts CC, explained Inspire has the space, structure and support already in place. She will discuss extending their digital support to incorporate this more sociable concept with her Libraries Management Team and escalate to their senior leadership team and report back. Hopefully, incorporate Co-op in an outreach programme. Refer to minutes for full details. SSS explained by how listening to residents and organising litter picks not only created improved communities but also could increase property values by up to 11.8%. See news article . MoU - Steve Smith (Notts County Council) is in the process of developing a new Memorandum of Understanding between NCC, Notts Police and Nottinghamshire Neighbourhood Watch, which will set out how both can support each and agreed actions. This is ongoing, but it is hoped that a draft MOU will be ready for in a month. Format will be similar to current SLA (columns) but language will be more collaborative.
Progress of Mansfield & Ashfield C2P project	SW	Refer to report plus PowerPoint. SW will be meeting with PT, P&CC, next month to see if he will offer any support to the C2P project. PT has funding set aside to invest in high crime areas. SW also discussed work to date with NWN to review digital platform offering a flexible process to receive information, to keep safe and well, in their preferred method of communication. M&A are waiting to see what action NWN take. SW believes there is confusion with the current neighbourhood alert as to the difference between NHW membership and receiving alerts. SW suggested liaising with Mansfield CVS re recruiting MSA volunteers in the Mansfield area, as many people are reluctant to travel, and HR suggested considering Mansfield Police Station's conference room as a potential venue for a listening skills course.
